LAST MONTH - JUNE 22nd - TROPICAL TREE L/D & W/S -G. LeBOLT

After some important Club Business involving sign-ups and decisions regarding our bus trip, etc., Diana brought forth the results of her experimentation with Bald Cypress seeds that were given to many of us by Bob at the last meeting. Only a few of us were successful at germinating the seeds. However, many of Diane's seeds had sprouted and she shared her seedlings and secrets with us. She just pushed the seeds into the soil, covered them, and they sprouted. AMAZING! Next George brought forth one of his "babies", about a foot tall and presented it to Bob. His success was multiple. All George did was put the seeds into water and when they sprouted he transplanted them into soil. Bob promised to bring in more seeds at the next meeting so that we can try again.

Priceless is the word that next described the demo and workshop that followed and indeed it was "price less". Generally, it costs the club about \$1,000 (including Lect/Demo, Workshop, transportation, food, etc.) to bring in a Guest Artist. Most do an excellent job but some occasionally leave something to be desired. Our Guest Artist this month is always a success, he has a reputation in the Bonsai Community that is second to none and has the artistic skills that are the envy of many. The program this month was among the best that I have witnessed in a long time.

This Artist took a lush Nerifolia Ficus shrub, and in less than an hour, converted it into a lovely Bonsai work of art. I can't wait to see it when all of the fine wiring is done and the tree has a chance to grow in the hands of the lucky winner, Bob Pruski.
