### <u>LAST MEETING —OCT 20TH– GUREST ARTIST — DAVID EASTERBOOK— AM</u> L/D & PM WORKSHOP

David Easterbrook always attracts our members and a large group was present for this meeting. The theme of the meeting was Maple bonsai trees. Maple branches will always tend to grow upward from the trunk and then bow downward from the weight of its leaves. Taper of the trunk is less important than delicate curvature and gentle flowing. These are the characteristics that create the loveliness of these trees.

To maintain close internodes and allow light to penetrate the inside branches, healthy trees can be defoliated several times per year, generally around May and again in July but no later than early September.

When pruning, leave no more than two buds at the end of each branch to encourage ramification.

David worked on a maple for the demonstration portion of the meeting with Peter helping with the wiring. The tree was won by Hank.

David supplied the workshop group with wonderful pre-bonsai maples that he collected and trained for several years. There are very few places where one could buy such valuable pre-bonsai specimens.

The afternoon was spent designing these lovely trees for those members who participated in the workshop - Mitch

#### For Hardy, Tropical and Sub-Tropical

- 1.) Fertilizing No to Hardy; Yes to Tropical
- 2.) Location—Prepare winter location; Bring Tropical indoors.
- 3.) Pests & Diseases Dormant spray for Hardy; Spray as required for Tropical.
- 4.) Potting Tropical Only.
- 5.) Pruning Hardy no drastic pruning; Tropical Yes
- 6.) Watering Less often.
