<u>LAST MEETING — March 10 Bonsai Artist Bob Mahalnic — Closter Nature Center, Ruckman Rd</u>

The last-minute substitution of Bob Mahalnic for Tyler Sherod, as visiting quest artist, was well attended with over fifteen members and guests bringing in over 25 trees for evaluation and work. Bob seated at a stationary spot, spent an appropriate amount of time on each tree, quickly suggesting improvements. Many of us then used the meeting as a workshop, with Peter, Ralf and others helping us do the suggested work. Cliff Lee re potted his hornbeam, which he purchased at one of our auctions and planted it in the soil we mixed at the February workshop. Susan Lee, a first-time new member had her friend's Austrian pine much reduced and new member Bob Hunter had his somewhat uninspired literati twisted into a more interesting pretzel. I got good insights about how to develop three trees that have had uncertain futures for years. This was a very successful productive, all day work shop costing only \$25 and we will be inviting Bob back in **November for a follow up on these trees as well as anything else participants bring in.**
